### Job Opportunity - Surf Life Saving Western Australia Lifeguard Service:

Surf Life Saving Western Australia (SLSWA) is a contracted provider of lifeguard services to land managers such as local and state government agencies. These services are generally provided where the volunteer system of SLSWA is unable to meet the demand for services; typically mid-week.

Contracted services are provided across ten (10) Local/State Government agencies of WA with 17 beaches patrolled by lifeguards. In order to fulfil the roster requirements for the above contracted services, SLSWA employs on average, fifty five (55) personnel within the lifeguard service.

SLSWA lifeguard service is in a position to offer Land Managers a professional and cost effective beach safety system. SLSWA lifeguards are offered industry standard and where appropriate nationally recognised qualifications. Many members of Surf Life Saving will already satisfy the qualification requirements and are in a unique position of being able to assist SLSWA in fulfilling its contracted service delivery obligations.

The SLSWA lifeguard service is looking for people who are excellent communicators, have a genuine willingness to contribute to the community, enjoy working with people from diverse backgrounds, have positive attitudes and are team players. It is also important that applicants are committed to maintaining and developing their skills and fitness and take a leading role in preventative actions.

If as a qualified lifesaving member of the Surf Life Saving, you believe you have the drive to be involved, you are encouraged to submit applications for assessment. It is particularly important that all you have the pre-requisite awards. If as a member you currently have a gap in the essential pre-requisite qualifications SLSWA is holding a lifeguard school for members, where you may be able to attain the required qualifications (please refer to Circular 06 -1516 - Essential Lifeguard Qualification Course 2015 or contact [speppler@slswa.com.au](mailto:speppler@slswa.com.au) for further information).

If your application meets the Selection Criteria, you will be invited to undertake a physical assessment and interview. If you successfully complete the assessment and are deemed suitable for employment, you will be offered to attend the SLSWA lifeguard inductions and thereafter be placed into the SLSWA lifeguard roster. For applicants to be eligible for a position they must meet the following criteria and awards:

## Essential Awards and Qualifications:

- Bronze Medallion or equivalent
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate or equivalent
- Current Senior First Aid Certificate or equivalent
- Current "C" Class driving license or equivalent

Other desirable qualifications:

- Spinal Management
- Silver Medallion – Patrol Captains award or equivalent

## Essential Criteria:

- Be fully available for induction between 21st -27th of November 2015.
- Be at least 18 years of age before the 21st of November 2015.
- Be able to complete a number of physical assessments:

- 400 metre Pool Swim in under 7:30 minutes
- Board Rescue (200 metres out to sea)
- Tube Rescue, (100 metres out to sea)
- Lifeguard Mission (complete in under 25 minutes):
  - 800 metre beach run
  - 400 metre surf swim
  - 800 metre beach run
  - 400 metre board paddle

Lifeguard applications are now available to submit and can be found at [www.lifeguards.com.au/myjobs/851](http://www.lifeguards.com.au/myjobs/851). A full information document is also available on the web page, it is important to read the document fully before submitting an application. Successful shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend a trial day and interview.
