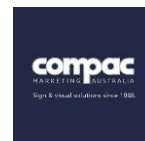

Keep the date free Sunday 9th April for our annual Champion Patrol Competition/Patrol Photo/Patrol Windup.

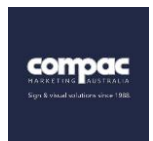
See who will be crowned Champion Patrol for 2017. Stay for the Annual Patrol Photo and then enjoy a drink and delicious food and celebrate the season with your team.

Accommodation is available at the Broome Camp School with dormitory style sleeping quarters and meals inclusive. Some limited camping is allowed but you would need to advise me very soon.

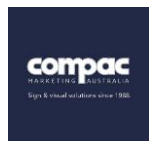
Earliest check in is Monday 3rd and latest check out is Friday 14th July.
