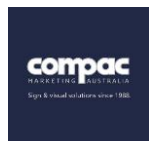

Pre requisites are you must:

- Be a current Bronze holder
- Hold your IRB crew certificate
- Hold or be training for your R.S.T. (Recreational skipper's ticket)
- Be 17 prior to the assessment
- Be a 2017 – 2018 financial member of Sorrento SLSC

Round 4 of the IRB championships was held at Sorrento on the weekend and a nicer day could not have been asked for.

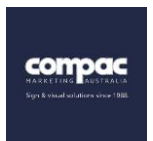

Sorrento members raced at round 2 of the Pool Rescue series Sunday with great results.

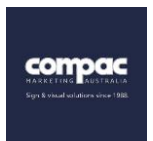
Our under 10 girls had a great day out and should be proud of their efforts placing in relay events and doing some great individual swims. These 5 girls had smiles on their faces all day.
