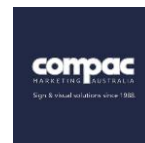

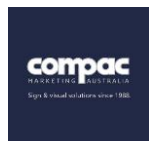
Watermans to the Wall Swim

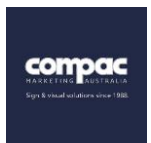
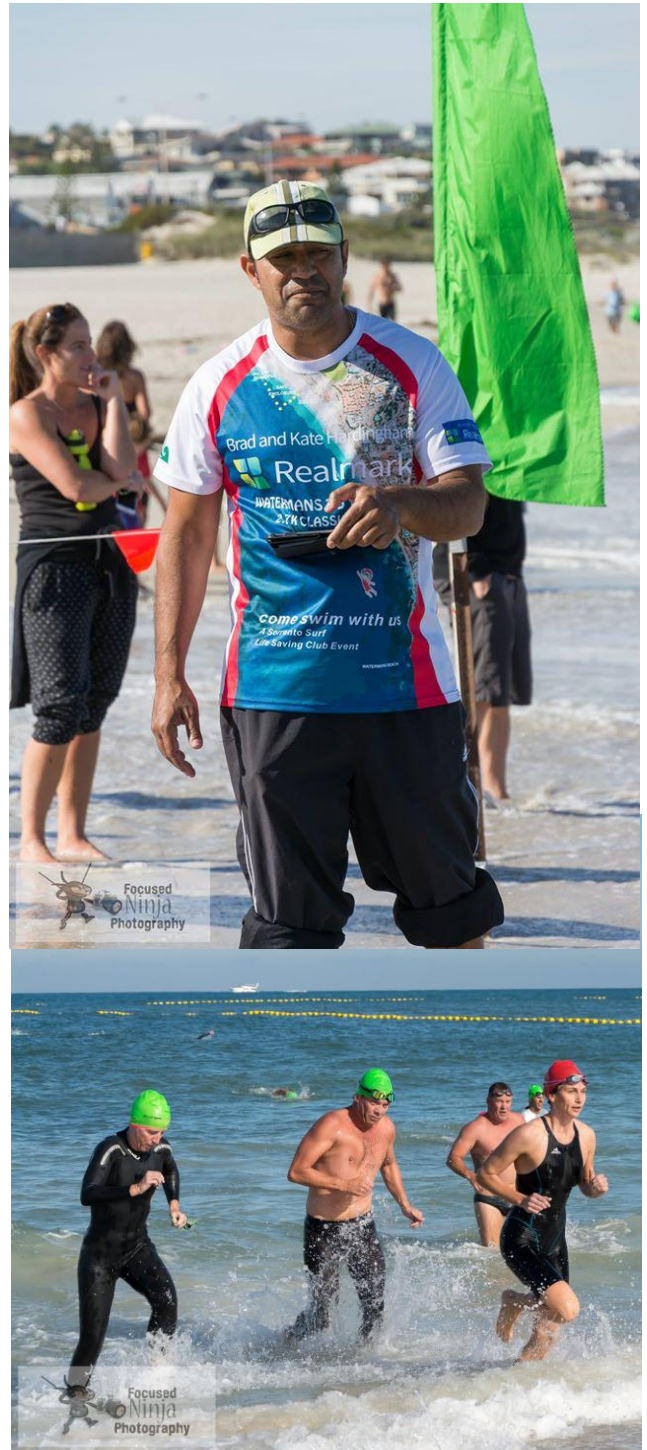

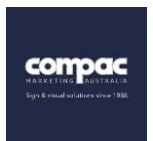
Competition - IRB Series - Round 1
