# COMPETITION COMMITTEE ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES



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# 1.0 OVERVIEW

The following document outlines the roles and responsibilities of each discipline captain at Sorrento Surf Life Saving Club. As per the Competition By-Laws, the Captains have overall responsibility for their individual discipline including equipment, coaching, training, performance, development, entries, and representation.

# 2.0 POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

#### 2.1 COACHING COORDINATOR

The Coaching Coordinator is responsible for providing leadership and guidance to club appointed coaches across all disciplines. The Coaching Coordinator represents coaches on the Competition Committee.

#### **RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director**

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Chair a coaching meeting min. four times per annum
- Ensure all coaches are adequately qualified as per SLSA regulations
- Chair the club selection committee with each head discipline coach and the Competition Director in attendance
- Ensure that Captains are presenting training numbers at Competition Committee Meetings
  Assist in the provision of coach education to coaches and age managers
- Assist the Competition Director in the recruitment of club coaches

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation
- SLS Coaching Mentor
- SLS Performance Level Coach (or working towards)
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching
- The Head Coach is appointed for 12 months.

Where no Coaching Coordinator is appointed the Head Coach from the Boat, Ski, Board, Water, IRB, R&R, March Past and Beach Disciplines will attend the Competition Committee in an ex-office capacity.

#### 2.2 BEACH CAPTAIN

The Beach Captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in Beach training and competition.

# **RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director**

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Care and maintenance of all the club's competition beach training equipment including starting blocks, flags and other equipment as relevant including correct storage.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing and equipment replacements in consultation with the Beach coach/es
- Oversee the conduct of Beach coaching by suitably accredited Beach coach/es.
- Monitor training attendance in consultation with the Beach coach/es and report monthly to the Competition Committee
- Encourage Beach athletes to enter SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events
- Attend SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events to support athletes
- Ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations
- Coordinate the bookings of local government or school-based training venues as required.
- Assist in the delivery of the Club Championships
- Promote Beach within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole

# **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of Beach competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to Beach events.
- The Beach Captain is appointed for 12 months.

#### 2.3 BOARD CAPTAIN

The Board Captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in board training and competition.

# **RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director**

- Care and maintenance of all the club's competition boards, including correct storage within the club house.
- To provide the contact point for any club member wishing to store personal boards within the club building and allocation of storage of non-club owned boards.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing board replacements.

- Ensure that the Board Coach is present at or in consultation with the Board coach
- Oversee the conduct of Board coaching by suitably accredited Board coach/es.
- Monitor training attendance in consultation with the Board coach/es and report monthly to the Competition Committee.
- Encourage Board athletes to enter SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events.
- Attend SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events to support athletes.
- Ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations.
- In collaboration with the Ski Captain arrange for Board/Ski Trailer transport to and from competitions and events.
- If not competing, assist in the delivery of the Club Championships.
- Promote Boards within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation.
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of board paddlers for competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to board events.
- Has a sound knowledge of OH&S regulations governing the storage and handling of boards.
- Is familiar with the appropriate road traffic regulations regarding the transport of boards.
- The Board Captain is appointed for 12 months.

#### 2.3 BOAT CAPTAIN

The boat captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in boat training and competition.

Responsible to: Competition Director

- Care and maintenance of all the club's competition boats, including correct storage within the club house.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing boat replacements in consultation with the boat coach/es.
- Oversee the conduct of boat coaching by suitably accredited boat coach/es and sweeps.

- Monitor training attendance in consultation with the boat coach/es and sweeps and report monthly to the competition committee.
- Encourage boat athletes to enter SLSC and club carnivals, competitions and events ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations.
- Attend SLSC and club carnivals, competitions and events to support athletes.
- Arrange for boat trailer transport to and from competitions and events.
- Promote boats within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

# **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'working with children check' legislation.
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of boat paddlers for competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to boat events. Has a sound knowledge of OH&S regulations governing the storage and handling of boats.
- Is familiar with the appropriate road traffic regulations regarding the transport of boats.

#### 2.4 IRB CAPTAIN

The IRB Captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in IRB training and competition.

**RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director** 

- Work closely with the Life Saving IRB Officer Care and maintenance of all the club's competition IRBs, including correct storage within the club house.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing IRB and motor replacements as well as repairs and maintenance.
- Ensure that the IRB Coach is present at or in consultation with the IRB Coach.
- Oversee the conduct of IRB coaching by suitably accredited IRB Coach/es.
- Monitor training attendance in consultation with the IRB coach/es and report monthly to the Competition Committee.
- Encourage IRB athletes to enter SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events Ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations.
- Attend SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events to support athletes.

- Arrange for IRB Trailer transport to and from competitions and events.
- Promote IRB within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation.
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of IRB competitors for competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to IRB events.
- Has a sound knowledge of OH&S regulations governing the storage and handling of IRBs.
- Is familiar with the appropriate road traffic regulations regarding the transport of IRBs.
- The IRB Captain is appointed for 12 months.
- Promote IRB's within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

# 2.5 WATER (SWIM) CAPTAIN

The Water Captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in Swim training and competition including ocean and pool rescue events.

# **RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director**

- Care and maintenance of all the club's competition buoys, fins and pool rescue equipment, including correct storage.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing new buoys, fins and equipment replacement in consultation with Swim coach/es.
- Oversee the conduct of Swim coaching by suitably accredited Swim coach/es.
- Monitor training attendance in consultation with coaches and athletes and report monthly to the Competition Committee.
- Encourage athletes to enter SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events.
- Attend SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events to support athletes.
- Ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations
- Sit as an active member on the Waterman's to Wall Committee.
- If not competing, assist in the delivery of the Club Championships, Presidents Marathon and Mile Swim.
- Approve Lane Bookings in consultation with the Swim Coach/es and Competition Director as appropriate.

Promote Swimming within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation.
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of Swimmers / Pool Rescue Athletes for competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to Swim / Pool Rescue events.
- The Water Captain is appointed for 12 months.

# 2.6 SKI CAPTAIN

The Ski Captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in Ski training and competition.

**RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director** 

- Care and maintenance of all the club's competition skis, paddles and other equipment including correct storage within the club house.
- To provide the contact point for any club member wishing to store personal skis within the club building and allocation of storage of non-club owned skis.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing new and equipment replacements in consultation with the relevant coach/es.
- Oversee the conduct of ski coaching by suitably accredited coach/es.
- Monitor training attendance in consultation with coach/es and report monthly to the Competition Committee.
- In collaboration with the Board Captain arrange for Board/Ski Trailer transport to and from competitions and events.
- Encourage athletes to enter SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events.
- Attend SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events to support athletes.
- Ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations.
- If not competing, assist in the delivery of the Club Championships.
- Promote Ski paddling within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation.
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of ski paddlers for competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to ski events.
- Has a sound knowledge of OH&S regulations governing the storage and handling of skis.
- Is familiar with the appropriate road traffic regulations regarding the transport of skis.
- The Ski Captain is appointed for 12 months.

# 2.7 OTHER CAPTAINS ROLES

This category includes Lifesaving, March Past and Rescue & Resuscitation. The discipline captain is responsible for the preparation and supervision of club participation in training and competition.

**RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director** 

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Care and maintenance of all the club's competition equipment, including correct storage relevant to the discipline.
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider purchasing new and equipment replacements.
- Ensure that the relevant Coach is present at or in consultation with the relevant Coach,
- Oversee the conduct of discipline coaching by suitably accredited Coach/es.
- Monitor training attendance in consultation with the coach/es and report monthly to the Competition Committee.
- Encourage athletes to enter SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events.
- Attend SLS and Club Carnivals, Competitions and Events to support athletes.
- Ensure that all athletes are suitably qualified and are adhere to club membership regulations.
- Promote the relevant discipline within Sorrento and SLSA as a whole.

# **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation.
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in coaching of Athletes for competition.
- Understands current competition rules relating to SLS events.
- The captain is appointed for 12 months.

#### 2.8 OFFICIALS LIAISON

The Officials Liaison is responsible for the development, education and wellbeing of the Club's Competition Officials

**RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director** 

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- At the start of each year prepare a list of members who are prepared to carry out the role of Competition Official and ensure those members are suitably qualified
- Promote and provide pathways for any member wishing to become a SLSA Competition Official
- Ensure all Competition Officials are aware of the SLSWA and SLSA competition Calendars.
- Ensure all Competition Officials are aware of any event rule changes
- Act on any feedback from Competition Officials on the conduct of SLSWA events
- Provide support services as necessary to any Competition Official
- Encourage Competition Officials to assist in the conduct of Club Events
- Ensure the Club is meeting its responsibility in providing Competition Officials to SLSWA events
- Build relationships with Surf Sports WA and carnival referees
- Report monthly to the Competition Committee
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider any purchasing and equipment replacements

# **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation
- Must be a Qualified Level 2 Competition Official or a Level 1 Official working towards Level 2
- Possess knowledge and/or experience in the conduct of Surf Life Saving Events.
- Knowledge of appropriate regulations regarding the safe conduct of SLSWA events.
- Understands the structure of Surf Sports WA and its regulations
- Good Communications skills.
- The Competition Liaison is appointed for 12 months.

# 2.9 HANDICAPPER

The Handicapper is responsible for the conduct of all intra club competitions and championship events.

**RESPONSIBLE TO: Competition Director** 

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- At the start of each year prepare a Competition Calendar for approval by the Competition Committee.
- Conduct Club Competition Events and Club Championship events, including setting the courses
- Ensure appropriate Water Safety is in place before starting any event
- Determine if conditions safe to conduct an event
- Set each member's Handicap for various events.
- Maintain Register of all event results
- Collate results to determine the various winners
- Report monthly to the Competition Committee
- Prepare budget costings for the competition committee to consider any purchasing and equipment replacements

# **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS REQUIRED:**

- Must adhere to current WA 'Working with Children Check' legislation
- Possesses knowledge and/or experience in the conduct of Surf Life Saving Events.
- Knowledge of appropriate regulations regarding the safe conduct of SLSWA events.
- Understands current competition rules relating to SLS events.
- Ability to set Handicaps.
- Good record keeping
- The Handicapper is appointed for 12 months.
